



In her third documentary account, Erika Fatland takes the reader on a journey that is unknown to even the most seasoned globetrotter. The five former Soviet Republics' Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan all became independent when the Soviet Union fell apart in 1991. How have these countries developed since then? With this in mind, Erika Fatland explores with her usual compassion and vast knowledge of these societies, their recent and ancient history, their culture and landscapes. She invites the reader to witness gripping human encounters and interesting accounts of how the Soviet heritage has influenced these countries, where the governing rule varies between experiments in democracy to pure dictatorship – a few of them with a personal cult and mismanagement unlike any other.

In these countries, that used to be the furthest border of the Soviet Union, life follows another pace of time. Alexander the Great's army brought with them the walnut from Arslanbob in Kyrgyzstan to Europe, and in the Yagnob Valley on the border of Tajikistan and Uzbekistan the population still speak Sogdian, the main language of the silk trail. In between the treasures of Samarkand and the bleakness of Soviet architecture, Erika Fatland moves with her openness towards the people and the landscapes around her. A rare and unforgettable travelogue.



Erika Fatland (b.1983) is a Norwegian author and social anthropologist. She has lived and travelled abroad extensively and speaks English, French, Russian, German, Italian and Spanish. Fatland has worked as a freelance journalist for a number of Norwegian journals and publications. For her thesis the field work was conducted in Beslan in North Caucasus, in 2007. Her book on the tragedy of Beslan, *The Village of Angels*, (2011) was nominated for the Norwegian Brage-prize. Fatland's debut as an author came in 2009 with the children's book, *The Parent War*. The book received good reviews and was chosen by the Norwegian Booksellers Association as part of the curriculum for Norwegian schools.







Over the course of these centuries the principles of warfare, financing wars, and military strategy have radically changed.

The author also elaborates on how technology, politics, and societal life all have an impact on the way wars are fought and, not least, how we as human beings perceive war and feel about war. Throughout the ages armed conflict has been an important element of historical development, just as shifting social and political climates have in decisive ways influenced how such conflicts have been waged.



彼得·克里斯蒂安·阿斯比约森是一名老师，尤根·莫埃是一名牧师，他们是15年的好朋友。

1841年，他们出版了第一部民间传说故事集。

1879年，该书出版了带有插图的新版。

其中的插画由Peter Nicolai Arbo (1831–1892), Hans Gude (1825–1903), Vincent Stoltenberg Lerche (no), Eilif Peterssen (1852–1928), August Schneider (1842–1873), Otto Sinding (1842–1909), Adolph Tidemand (1814–1876), and Erik Werenskiold (1855–1938)绘制。

Norwegian Folktales is a collection of Norwegian folktales and legends by Peter Christen Asbjørnsen and Jørgen Moe. It is also known as *Asbjørnsen and Moe*, after the collectors.

The work's popularity is partly attributable to Norway's newly won partial independence, and the wave of nationalism that swept the country in the 19th century; and the Norwegian written language they contributed to developing (i.e. what would become Bokmål); their language style struck a balance: it was a national language distinct from the Danish of their overlords, but more dignified and refined than the rustic rural dialect in pure form.

Asbjørnsen and Moe was inspired by the German folktale collectors, the Brothers Grimm, not merely to emulate their methodology, but drawing encouragement by that their endeavor was a work of national importance, especially as the Grimms openly gave high praise for the Norske folkeeventyr. Asbjørnsen and Moe applying the principles espoused by the Grimms, for instance, using a simple linguistic style in place of dialects, while maintaining the original form of the stories. Moreover, Asbjørnsen and Moe did not publish collected folktales in the raw, but created "retold" versions, seeking to reconstruct the lost Urform of the tales — although the alterations performed were not as drastic as the Grimms sometimes allowed license for themselves. The Norwegian pair also collected tales from the field themselves, in contrast to the Grimms.

Asbjørnsen, a teacher, and Moe, a minister, had been friends for about 15 years when in 1841 they published the first volume of folktales – the collection of which had been an interest of both for some years.

Illustrators

The first fully illustrated of the book was the 1879 edition of Asbjørnsen's *Norske folke- og huldre-eventyr*, which featured the artwork of a battery of artists: Peter Nicolai Arbo (1831–1892), Hans Gude (1825–1903), Vincent Stoltenberg Lerche (no), Eilif Peterssen (1852–1928), August Schneider (1842–1873), Otto Sinding (1842–1909), Adolph Tidemand (1814–1876), and Erik Werenskiold (1855–1938). In later editions Werenskiold and Theodor Kittelsen became prominent illustrators.
