

## PRODUCTION SUBSIDY FOR PUBLICATION OF NORWEGIAN ILLUSTRATED NON-FICTION

Foreign publishers, including publishers in the Nordic region, can apply for production subsidies for the publication of Norwegian non-fiction containing a large number of illustrations or with exceptionally demanding technical production requirements. The publication must uphold the same production standard as the Norwegian publication, and the publisher must simultaneously apply for a translation subsidy from NORLA, Norwegian Literature Abroad.

It is possible to apply for a production subsidy from NORLA for up to NOK 16,000.

The application deadlines for production subsidies are the same as for the translation subsidies for non-fiction: **1 February, 1 June and 1 October.**
