So what happens when temperatures rise?

The threat of EXTREME WEATHER increases. All over the world. The last few years we've already seen worse storms, more intense monsoons in Asia, droughts in East-Africa, and enormous wildfires in California, Australia and even Sweden.

All of that is bad enough. But the changing weather and seasons also affect all living things.

If spring comes too early...

Plants might flower and die before the insects wake up...

- ... insects who live off of pollen die ...
- ... birds who live off of insects die.

Ecosystems collapse.

45.

And plants are our food. We need them to live.

Additionally, climate change will be most difficult for those who live in the Global South. This is quite unfair, because it's us in the North who pollute the most, and Norway makes lots of money by selling oil and gas.

Many will have to move out of their country because it will become impossible to live there.

46.

That is why it's extra important that <u>we</u> take responsibility, and do our part. Every 0.1 degree of heating we can stop matters. For plants, for animals, and for us humans.

Green measures don't save the world alone, but it's a step in the right direction, and we need all the steps we can take.

From the children who'll live here in 2070.

I can scan it with my tablet, and then we can send it off right away.
