Luka, the street artist and environmentalist dressed in black, grew up on a farm with the smell of cow dung and a mother who barely cares. Their brutal collision is the start of a gut-wrenching and infinitely beautiful love story.

It is a dramatic tale that takes the reader's breath away, a raw, fast-paced, tender and lyrical book that speaks to the heart.
