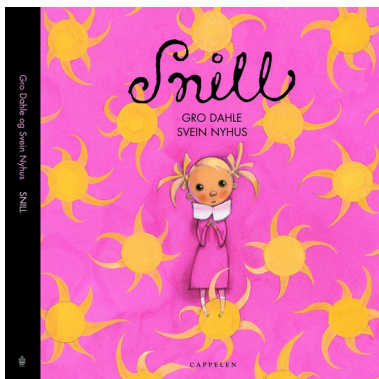

Gro Dahle (b. 1962) has written a number of poetry collections and children's books. Dahle stands out as a stylistically naïve, imaginative, quick-witted and burlesque writer – a poet treading her own path. As a children's book writer she is known for her poetic books on themes that are often given little attention. Her poetry collections *Regnværsgåter* and *Hunder tusen timer* have solid places in the canon of modern Norwegian poetry. She has also published novels and short stories.

Svein Nyhus (b. 1962) is an artist and children's book author. He has won a number of awards, among them the Brage Prize and the Award for the Year's Most Beautiful Picture Book. He is recognized for the illustrations he has done for books by Gro Dahle and also for Princess Märtha Louise's book *Hvorfor de kongelige ikke har krone på hodet*.
