这是一部与众不同的世界史——这是通过那些被从地图上抹去了的国家的邮票来进行讲述的。

在1840年的英格兰发行了第一张“黑便士”的邮票之后，过去175年间，有超过1000个国家曾经发行过他们自己的邮票。但是，这中间大部分的国家都已经不存在了。他们中有的国家的名字还能让人们把它们和一些意思联系起来，例如拉布安和“饥饿”，布霍帕和“环境灾难”。还有一些，已经没有办法联系上任何意思了，例如拉布安，塔努图瓦和非优莫。这些消失的国家都有很多充满魅力的故事。无论是非常短暂存在的东卡累利亚国，这个国家只在1922年的冬天里存在了几周的时间，还是时间更长一些的橙色自由国家，还有在19世纪末曾经庆祝了自己独立50年的波尔共和国。

这本书呈现了五十个消亡的国家。这些国家遍布了19世纪到20世纪的世界不同地区和时间段，他们的意识形态，政治形态和为了资源、移民浪潮所进行的斗争，以及发生在他们身上的大大小小的战争。他们所发行过的邮票可以充分体现出他们的形象。邮票是他们宝贵的国家形象、地位和野心的保存，如论是革命性的还是殖民性的国家。这本书是根据邮票和历史见证者支撑起来，里面也有历史的分析。每一个灭亡的国家都有属于自己的邮票和地图。

This is a different kind of world history - told through stamps from countries that have been erased from the map.

More than 1000 countries have issued their own stamps during the past 175 years since the first "Penny Black" was introduced in England in 1840. Most of them no longer exist. Some of their names will bring back associations, such as Biafra and "famine" and Bhopal and "environmental disaster." Others, few of us will associate with anything, like Labuan, Tannu Tu-va and Fiume. These lost countries have fascinating stories to tell, whether they were short-lived like Eastern Karelia, which lasted only a few weeks during the winter war of 1922, or more tenacious such as the Orange Free State, a Boer Republic which celebrated 50 years as an independent state in the late 1800s.

The book presents fifty of these countries that collapsed. The range of countries reflects different aspects of world history during the 19th and 20th centuries, with their ideologies, imperialism, struggle for resources, immigration waves and major and trivial wars. As such, the stamps with their motifs and symbols must be considered as official self-presentations. They were quite precise expressions of the ruling authorities' desired self-image, positions and ambitions, whether revolutionary or colonial. Besides stamps, the book is based on eyewitness accounts, as well as later historical analyses.

Each vanished country is presented with detailed maps and stamps.

艾丽卡·法特兰的《边境》这本书位于国际上非虚构类小说的前列。通过一次迷人的旅行，一场知识之旅，人性的相遇，历史的洞察和遥远距离，艾丽卡·法特兰沿着看似无穷无尽的俄罗斯边境线，从朝鲜一直到远东地区，穿过俄罗斯的在中亚和高加索接壤的州，穿过里海与黑海的海岸线，进行旅行。她经过了被战争洗礼过的乌克兰，普京在那里进行着现代俄罗斯的猛烈扩张，然后她通过东欧继续向北，经过14个国家，超过两万公里后来到了俄罗斯和挪威的边境线，濒临北极。这趟行程中还通过了冰冷海洋的东北航道，一条被冰雪封锁的道路，而现在被视为新的海上通商道路，通往东方。这趟旅行中有版图巨大的俄罗斯，这个世界上面积最大的国家。

这是一本关于俄罗斯和俄罗斯历史的书，但是作者没有进入这个国家本身；他的主题在于拥有一个强大的邻国，并在历史上一直进行着扩张。这种国与国之间巨大的文化差异作者在这趟旅行中发现到的，也是一种常见的情况，能够用不同方式来进行定义：住在俄罗斯的隔壁。

《边境》这本书的描述丰富多彩，有趣而带有一些悲情的色彩，里面令人难以置信的故事包括了很多基础的地缘政治的条件。同时，它也是一本对于文化、人民和风景的生动描述的作品，作者在这一过程中经历了许多英雄事迹。



艾丽卡·法特兰（出生于1983年）是一位挪威作家和社会人类学家。她长期旅居在国外，掌握英语、法语、俄语、德语、意大利语和西班牙语。法特兰曾是一名无国界记者，为多家挪威杂志和出版物撰稿。2007年，她曾经研究过别斯兰市北高加索地区，并写了论文。她的作品《别斯兰的悲剧：天使之村》（2011年）被挪威布拉格奖提名。法特兰于2009年发表了处女作，儿童文学作品《父母的战争》。这本书收获了好评，并被挪威书商协会选入了挪威学校的大纲。

The Border places Erika Fatland at the forefront of international non-fiction prose. On a captivating journey, a tour-de-force of knowledge, human encounters, historical insights and sweeping distances, Erika Fatland travels along the seemingly endless Russian border – from North Korea in the Far East through Russia's bordering states in Asia and the Caucasus, crossing the Caspian Ocean and the Black Sea along the route. The journey takes her to war-torn Ukraine, where Putin's modern Russia is again pushing violently for expansion, and then continues north through Eastern Europe, finishing after 14 countries and more than 20 000 kilometres at the Russian-Norwegian border, verging on the Arctic. The itinerary also takes the reader through the icy waters of the Northeast passage, a route until recently blocked by ice, now seen as the new commercial maritime pathway to the East. The journey hence encompasses the enormous territory that is Russia, the largest country in the world.

It is a book about Russia and Russian history without the writer ever entering Russia itself; it is a book on the topic of being the neighbours of that mighty, expanding empire throughout history. The enormous cultural differences between the countries that the author visits are eclipsed by the one, common factor, which in different ways has defined them all: Living next door to Russia. *The Border* narrates the colourful, exciting, tragic and often unbelievable histories that have evolved due to this fundamental, geopolitical condition. At the same time, it is a fascinating and vivid description of the cultures, peoples, landscapes and heroic individuals the author encounters along the border.

Erika Fatland (b. 1983) is a Norwegian author and social anthropologist. She has lived and travelled abroad extensively and speaks English, French, Russian, German, Italian and Spanish. Fatland has worked as a freelance journalist for a number of Norwegian journals and publications. For her thesis the field work was conducted in Beslan in North Caucasus, in 2007. 在达到北冰洋的班加拉口岸之后，彼得·哈姆斯塔德船长和他们环保护卫船“鲍勃·巴克”船上的一行人开始进行了一场前所未有的追捕活动。

一艘名为“闪电”的偷猎脱网渔船通过不停地更换旗帜，隐藏所有者，伪造证件，在过去的十多年中通过非法的海上偷猎活动每年平均赚取到了五百万英镑。

2013年，国际刑警组织在全球发布了“闪电”偷猎船的通缉令，但是海洋保护组织用了很长时间才在北极地区捕捉到了一点儿关于它的线索。通过四个月不间断的努力，“鲍勃·巴克”号终于跟上了“闪电”号。

对“闪电”号的追捕过程现在已在全世界进行报道，但是本书的作者是第一个向挪威《每日经济报》进行文章报道的人。他们追踪着这些罪犯，一直到了西班牙，揭露了他们伪造文书的罪行，还有他们是如何在海洋中进行非法偷猎的。

关于“闪电”号的故事并非个案。在北冰洋、大西洋、印度洋，还有太平洋，有成吨的鱼每天都在被偷捕。

非法捕鱼的罪行是没有边界的。这本书是关于大型巨额财富的国际犯罪的故事。

After reaching the Banzare bank in the Arctic Ocean, captain Peter Hammarstedt and the crew of his environmental campaigning ship «Bob Barker» embarked on a chase unlike any seen before.

By way of frequent flag changes, hidden ownership, false papers and helped along by antiquated regulations for stopping crime at sea, the trawler «Thunder» was able to continue its illegal fishing activity in ocean areas around Antarctica for more than 10 years making as much as £5 million a year.

In 2013, Interpol put out a notice for the ship internationally, but still it took the environmental organisation Sea Shepherd to finally pin down the poachers in a desolate ocean area around Antarctica. For four consecutive months, «Bob Barker» followed in the wake of the notorious poaching trawler «Thunder».

The hunt for «Thunder» has now been reported all over the world but the authors were the first to tell the story in a series of articles in the Norwegian newspaper Dagens Næringsliv. They followed the trail to the criminal kingpins in Spain, uncovered comprehensive fraud surrounding the ship's papers and exposed how the vessel was used for rampant criminal activity at sea.

«Thunder's» story isn't unique. In the Antarctic Ocean, the Atlantic, the Indian Ocean as well as the Pacific, tonnes of fish are caught illegally every day.

Illegal fishing is a crime without borders. This is the story of big money and powerful international crime syndicates.



Eskil Engdal (51) has worked as a feature journalist at the Norwegian broadsheet Dagens Næringsliv for more than 20 years. He has won the prestigious SKUP journalism award (2001), the International Reporter's Journalism Award (2012) and the «Golden Pen» (2013).

Kjetil Sæter (41) has worked as a journalist for the broadsheets Aftenposten, Finansavisen and Dagens Næringsliv, and still works as a feature journalist for the latter. He has won two SKUP diplomas (2007 and 2010), the SKUP award (2011) and the Schibsted Journalism Award (2008). Both authors currently work at Dagens Næringsliv's weekly magazine, Lørdagsmagasinet.

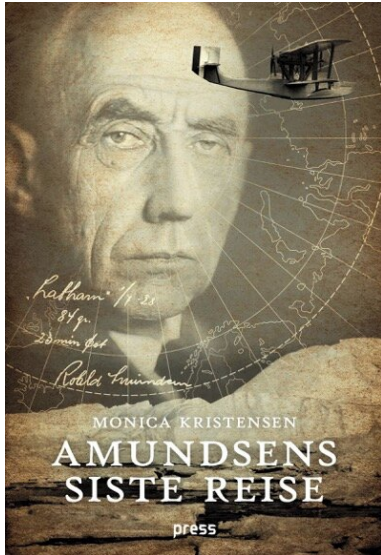

1928年5月25日，意大利的一艘飞艇“意大利号”在斯瓦尔巴特群岛以北失事。当时，它正在从北极探险结束后返回的路上，这件事成为了欧洲各地的头版头条新闻。这次失事标志着北极历史上最大的救援行动之一的开始。救援行动成为了北方地区的一场高级别政治游戏。6月18日，老牌极地英雄罗尔德·阿蒙森离开特隆姆瑟，和另外5个人一起登场了法国飞机“莱瑟姆”号。在三个小时后，根据雷达信号的现实，这架飞机正在飞往熊岛的路上。这也是我们最后一次收到关于罗尔德·阿蒙森的消息。“莱瑟姆”和它的全部成员都消失了。1928年，罗尔德·阿蒙森是56岁。他当时有财务问题，他最后一次探险保守批评，他是一名已经上了年纪的极地英雄，声望不再。“莱瑟姆”的这次援救行动只不过是 他为了重建声誉，回到大众视野的行为而已。但是这次探险的装备很差，组织得也不好。阿蒙森是否意识到了他将要冒的危险？那艘飞机上的人都发生了什么？莫妮卡·克里斯滕森是挪威当代最优秀的犯罪小说家之一，也在非虚构类作品中取得了很大的成就。在《阿蒙森最后的旅行》中，她将优秀的写作技巧融入她找到的材料中，即北极的历史。她根据迄今尚未发表过的信息来源，刻画出了一个尖锐且生动的阿蒙森的肖像，从事探查了我们未知的北极的历史——并讲述了一个充满戏剧性的不可思议的北方故事。

这部作品是挪威的国家英雄人生中最后几天的闪光点。

On May 25th, 1928 the Italian airship "Italia" was wrecked north of Svalbard. It was on its way back from an expedition to the North Pole which had made headlines all over Europe. The wreck marked the beginning of one of the greatest rescue operations in Arctic history. The rescue action soon became part of a high political game for the Northern areas. On June 18th the old Polar hero Roald Amundsen left Tromsø to join the race together with five others on board the French plane "Latham". Three hours later signals were received from the plane on its way to Bjørnøya. This is the last time we hear from Roald Amundsen. "Latham" and the entire crew disappeared without a trace.

In 1928 Roald Amundsen was 56 years old. He had financial problems, his last expeditions had been heavily criticized, he was an aging Polar hero with a faded reputation. The rescue action of the "Latham" was simply necessary in order for him to reestablish himself in the eyes of the public. But the expedition was poorly equipped and badly organized. Did Amundsen realize the risk he was taking? And what happened to the plane and the crew on board?

Monica Kristensen is known as one of Norway's finest crime writers of today, and is also highly successful as a nonfiction writer. In *Amundsens siste reise* she invests her skill as a storyteller in a material that she knows better than most, viz. the history of the Arctic. Based on so far unpublished sources she delivers a sharp and moving portrait of Amundsen while at the same time examining an unknown part of our Arctic history – and telling a dramatic and incredible story from the North.

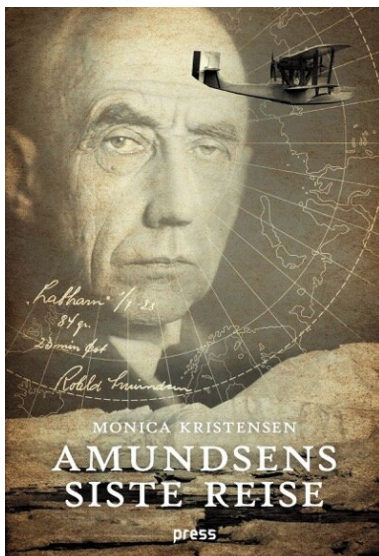

This is a highly original book that combines medicine and anthropology. Around the world, large groups of people have settled in extreme places and there are regular expeditions to the top of Mount Everest. People winter in Antarctica, others dive in the Mariana Trench and refugees cross scorching deserts and deep oceans. We move and live in places where we should not be able to cope.

What happens to the body when it is exposed to extreme cold, heat, altitude and depth? Which challenges are humans exposed to when diving and why do we get altitude sickness? The book looks at how different peoples and individuals have managed to acclimatise to extreme environments, and how we adapt and survive in such conditions. The author describes how our body adjusts, and discusses the more practical aspects, such as clothing and diet. *Life on the Edge* is a fascinating book that journeys into the body and out into the world, and joins medical knowledge and social anthropology.

The book is illustrated with photographs and instructive drawings.



Erik Sveberg Dietrichs (b. 1985) is a medical doctor and scholar. He finished his PhD at the world's most northerly university, in the Arctic city of Tromsø, in 2015. Dietrichs has written numerous popular science and academic articles about medicine and history, and regularly gives lectures. He has travelled in over 60 countries, and is interested in how people adapt and survive in some of the harshest environments in the world.

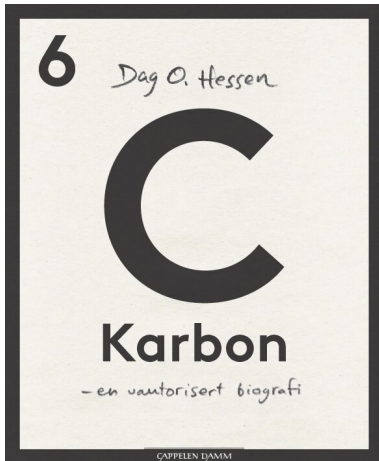

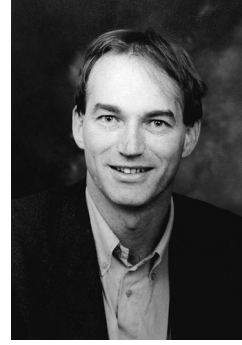

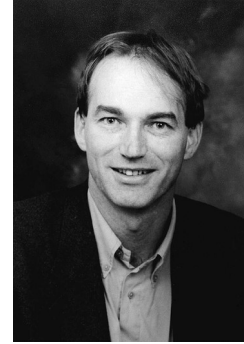
