



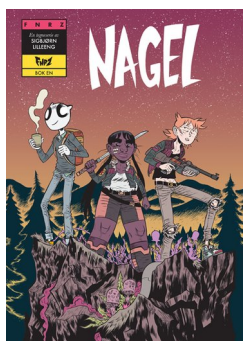
Ole Mathismoen and Jenny Jordahl (illustrator)

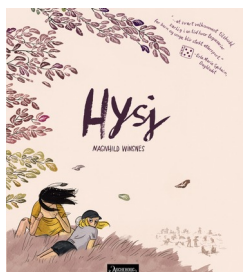

Do you remember Chicken Man? The superhero who saved the world from devious criminals and dangerous situations, despite always peeing himself in terror?

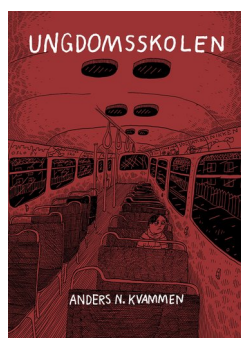
Now he is back again - more afraid and cowardly than ever!

Junior High (Ungdomsskolen)

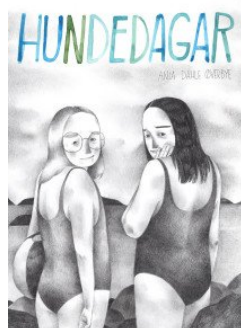
Young Adult Graphic Novel | No Comprendo Press | 2016 | 126 pages
