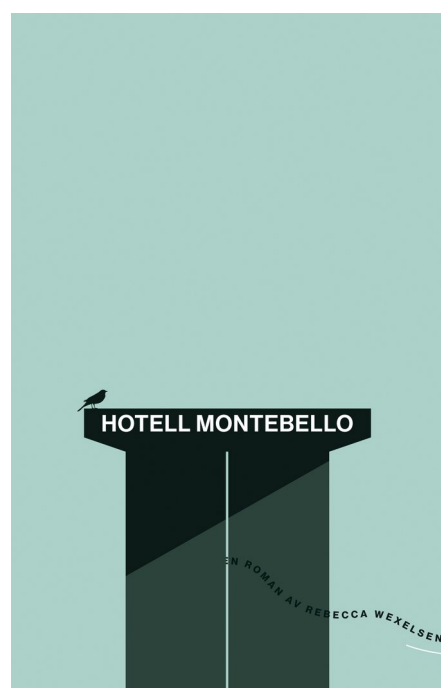
You might as well not exist.
