



Ellen Støkken Dahl is a medical doctor who has worked for several years advising young people, refugees and sex workers on matters of sexual health. Her first book *The Wonder Down Under* (2017), written with Nina Brochmann, became an international bestseller and a cultural phenomenon with their message of empowerment through scientific knowledge. Fall 2022 Ellen Støkken Dahl had her debut as a solo author with the book *Sleeping With the Enemy*, a narrative non-fiction about sexually transmitted infections.

Dahl and her co-author Brochmann has also written two books for younger readers *The Girl Book* and *The Boy Book*. With them they are equipping a new generation to make informed choices about their bodies and sexual well-being. 

金·希尔达（1966年生）在奥斯陆大学获得北欧维京人和中世纪文化研究硕士学位，现任圣哈尔瓦德学院历史讲师。他是挪威历史最悠久、规模最大的维京时期鲜活历史再现协会的前会长。希尔达出版了许多关于维京人的书，其中包括与维加德·维克合著的《维京人战争》2011/2017。该书在2012年获得了萨迦奖。这一重要且广受好评的作品已销往丹麦、法国、英国、西班牙和瑞典。

希尔达的作品还包括《维京人-海上掠夺者》（2017）和《维京人最伟大的战斗》（2020）。他还参与了几部电视纪录片。其中包括：旅游频道梅根·福克斯的《迷失传奇》和国家地理的最新节目《维京人：兴衰》。



Auðr means wealth. It was a common name for women in the Viking age, emphasising their importance in society. They were poets, skilled artisans and entrepreneurs who had their own ships. Women traded, led expeditions and played a crucial role in sharing knowledge, educating and protecting societal values. It was women who were responsible for textile manufacture and the preparation and storage of food, in addition to their important duties as healers.

In this book, we follow Aud the Deep-Minded, a rural Norwegian woman, on a 4,000 kilometre journey throughout her life, from her childhood in Norway to her adulthood in Ireland, Scotland and the Hebrides and her old age in Iceland. Kim Hjarðar uses Aud's story as a prism. How can we consider the role of women and the opportunities available to them in the Viking period?

Women in the Viking Age offers a journey of discovery through a history that has been overlooked. Through engaging writing and thought-provoking illustrations of both reconstructions and archaeological finds, the book provides a fascinating insight into the lives of Viking women.



Kim Hjarðar (b. 1966) has an MPhil in Nordic Viking and Medieval Culture studies from the University of Oslo, and works as a Lector of History at St. Hallvard College. He is a former head of Norway's oldest and biggest association for living history re-enactments of the Viking period. Hjarðar has published many books about the Vikings, among them *Vikings at War (Vikinger i krig)*, 2011/2017, with Vegard Vike. The book was awarded the Saga Prize in 2012. This major and well-received work has been sold to Denmark, France, the UK, Spain and Sweden. Hjarðar's works also include *Vikings - Raiders from the Sea* (Casemate 2017) and *The Vikings' Greatest Battles (Vikingenes største slag)*, 2020. He has also participated in several TV documentaries. Among them: Travel Channel's *Legend of the Lost* with Megan Fox and National Geographic's newest show, *Vikings – The Rise and Fall*.

The Sognefjord is an elongated sea inlet banked by steep valley walls. The fjord was formed by glaciers over the course of millions of years.

Nature writer Sigri Sandberg is a restless mother of two who lives in several places. Her restlessness is compounded by death and illness in the lives of loved ones and upsetting reports about the state of the planet. She longs for peace of mind. She wonders about what home really is and what it means to belong somewhere. Sandberg decides to row the Sognefjord, the more than 200 kilometers of the world's longest navigable fjord, in an old wooden rowboat. She starts at the mouth of the fjord, in the area where she lived as a child, and rows inland, toward the farm where she now lives part-time.

Along the way she explains how the fjord was created, describes daily life back when the fjord was the main transport artery and elaborates on wind and currents, and life above and below the water surface. She rows with her husband, her girlfriends, and her mother – on different legs of the journey. She navigates waves and drama but also stretches of calm water and finds time for singing and skinny-dipping.

This is a beautiful story about Norway's longest fjord – and an attempt to find home.

For over twenty years, Sigri Sandberg has worked for various Norwegian media outlets. She spent several years living on the arctic island of Svalbard and has written books about nature, wilderness philosophy, climate, and polar regions.
